Comprehensive Advanced Palliative Care Education (CAPCE)

Combining the "art" and "science" of Hospice Palliative Care (HPC) for nurses (RN/PRN/NP). This course embeds best practice standards and aligns with the Model to Guide Hospice Palliative Care. CAPCE focuses on the development and role of the nurse as a Hospice Palliative Care resource for the inter-professional team in long-term care homes, agencies, hospitals and communities.

Components of CAPCE include:

- Self-directed reading and reflection (8-chapter Program Guide)
- 6 e-learning modules
- 3 in-person, case-based learning sessions (CBL 4 hours in length)
- <u>6 in-person</u>, coaching sessions with Palliative Care Consultant (CS 2 hours in length)
- 8 peer-to-peer exchanges (learning debrief)
- 2 practical application assignments
- Plus 1 contact by e-mail & 1 by phone with local Palliative Care Consultant
- This course will take approximately 5 months to complete
- This course will require 3-4 hours of study time per week

CAPCE Selection Criteria:

- Completion of the Fundamentals of Hospice Palliative Care Program CORE
- Completion of the Fundamentals of Hospice Palliative Care Program ENHANCED
- Minimum of 1 year experience (or equivalent) caring for people with progressive, life-limiting illnesses
- Access to an internet-enabled computer & Knowledge of basic computer programs
- Applications will be screened and successful candidates will be contacted by email to complete the registration process
