

COVID-19 PANDEMIC

SAFETY MEASURES FOR AUTHORIZED VISITORS

THE SAFETY OF OUR RESIDENTS, FAMILIES AND STAFF IS PARAMOUNT

AUTHORIZED VISITOR

- only authorized visitors are permitted to visit resident
 - definition: one person only, may not switch with another individual
- resident's minor children (less than 18 years) are permitted ONE 2-hour visit each, one child at a time and may be accompanied by the authorized visitor, on Saturday or Sunday between 8 a.m. and 4 p.m.
- all visiting must be carried out in resident's room

SCREENING

- screening is mandatory for everyone entering the hospice
 - a mask is provided to visitor upon screening
 - mask must be worn at all times while in common areas of the building

OUTERWEAR

- coats and other outerwear must be stored in wardrobe located in resident's room

COMMON AREAS

- all common areas are closed to visitors
 - this includes: kitchen, dining area, family room, all other common sitting areas
 - coffee area is open to residents and authorized visitors
 - though beverage and snacks must be consumed in resident's room

HAND SANITIZING

- hands must be sanitized each time one enters and leaves resident's room

SOCIAL DISTANCING

- social distancing must be carried out at all times

END-OF-LIFE VISITS (EOL)

- definition: when residents are in their last hours of life (hospice healthcare providers will advise)
 - during this time, other essential visitors may visit resident to say their final goodbyes (one at a time)
